<u>ATTENTION RESIDENTS</u> **Bogus callers may be active in your area**



- · We have recently had bogus callers claiming to be from professional companies and services such as a Water Company, the Police service in the Southminster and Dunmow areas.
- They can be very persuasive and convincing, and may also use props such as identity cards or work overalls/uniform to convince you that they are genuine.
- · Genuine callers will always knock on your front door and wait for you to check their ID and if need be for you to make a phone call to their company before allowing them in they will also leave if you are unsure and do not wish to allow them access to your home they will not force their way in. If you are in any doubt and are concerned phone 999 immediately and report your worries and concerns.
- If **you are** expecting a professional worker to be visiting your house, before you let them in, follow the above advice and check their identity with their company first. If it is Gas, Electric or Water there will be a contact number on your bill. If the caller says they are police you can call 0300 333 4444 to verify the identity of the caller or in an **emergency 999**.
- · Always make sure that your back door is shut and locked at all times especially before you go to the front door always put the chain on before opening the door to anyone better still, if you have a window to the front of your property, use that to speak through to check your callers details instead of the front door.
- · Close and lock the windows in the rooms you are not using.

Community speedwatch update





The speedwatch team have been out at selected locations in and around Tile Kiln, there have been reports of a small number of offenders who will be contacted in due course. It was noted that the presence of a number of people in high visibility jackets wielding a speed measuring device served as an adequate deterrent and probably caused drivers to be more aware of their speed. We hope that this will help in making drivers more aware and thereby keeping our roads safer.
